CLASSROOM RULES

- **BE SAFE**
- **BE RESPECTFUL**
- **BE RESPONSIBLE**

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- **Keep hands and feet to self**
- **Use appropriate inside voice while speaking**
- **Wait your turn to talk**
- **Follow directions on first request**
- **Use only kind words towards others**
- **Use “Mr”, “Mrs” and “Ms” when speaking to adults**
- **Be willing to help others**
- **Schoolwork must be done before free time**
- **Wait patiently for your turn on technology devices**
- **Ask before touching anyone’s belongings**
- **Save playtime for P.E.**
- **Tell the TRUTH**

***Students are rated on their behavior each class period. He/She can earn a +1 for good behavior, a 0 for average behavior and a -1 for poor behavior. These points are added at the end of each day to determine the student’s level for the next day. The level’s privileges and restrictions are explained on the following pages.**

LEVEL SYSTEM

Level One (8 pts.)

- “Secret Agent status” (teacher assistant)
- Drinks/snacks in class
- Classroom iPads
- All privileges

Level Two (6-7 pts.)

- No escort
- Free time when done with assignments
- May use personal technology devices, school issued iPads or school desktops during free time
- May sit with other students during lunch in cafeteria

Level Three (2-5 pts.)

- May sit at table or teacher assigned area
- May speak with other students
- Must raise hand for any questions/needs
- Must be escorted by adult out of classroom
- Must sit in assigned area during lunch in cafeteria

Level Four (-8 to 1 pts.)

- Must stay at assigned cubicle
- No talking with other students
- Must raise hand for any questions/needs
- May only read or draw during free time
- Must sit in assigned area during lunch in cafeteria
- All assignments must be completed before getting off level 4 regardless of points

Possible Consequences for Inappropriate Behavior

- Loss of points
- Loss of privileges
- Loss of level
- Focus Desk (student must sit at a specified desk until he/she regains self-control - may be required to complete a "Think Sheet" addressing his/her behavior)
- After school detention
- Office referral
- Student is subject to all HMS discipline procedures

*Removal from outside classes for negative behavior will result in automatic drop to level 4.

*Leaving classroom without permission will result in automatic drop to level 4.

"Shut Down" Restrictions

(Used when a majority or all of the students are making poor behavior choices.)

- Must stay at assigned cubicle
- Need to ask permission to leave assigned desk for any reason
- May not talk with other students
- May only talk to teachers about assignments or schoolwork
- Must eat at assigned area in cafeteria
- May only read or draw during free time
- Must write a paper on behaviors that contributed to shut down and how they will be changed. (1 pg.)
- For every 3 rule violations, there will be $\frac{1}{2}$ day added to "shut down" status
